

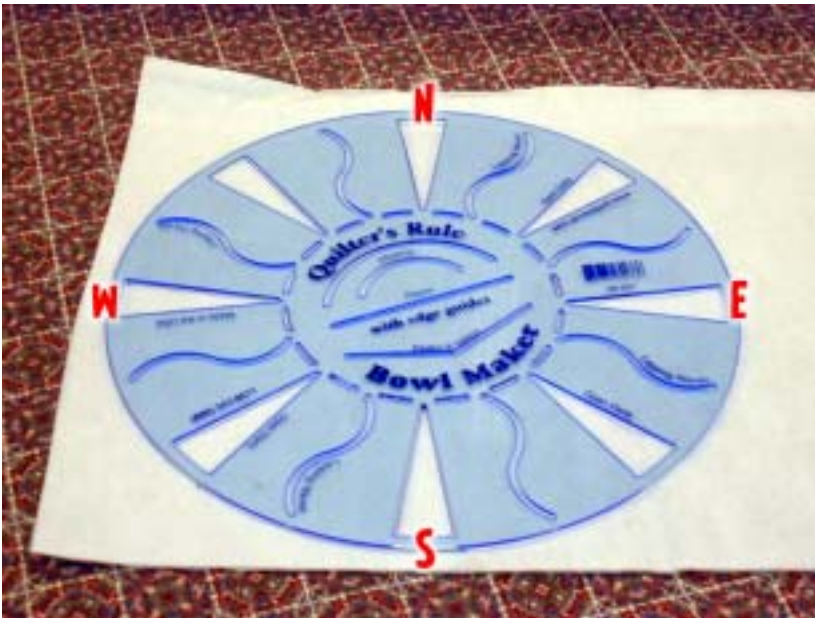
Instructions

Super Bowl XXXIX Fabric Serving Basket *

Supplies: Stiff Stuff cut to desired length, Quilter's Rule Bowl Maker, 2 cuts of fabric (matching length of Stiff Stuff), sewing machine, thread, pen, creativity



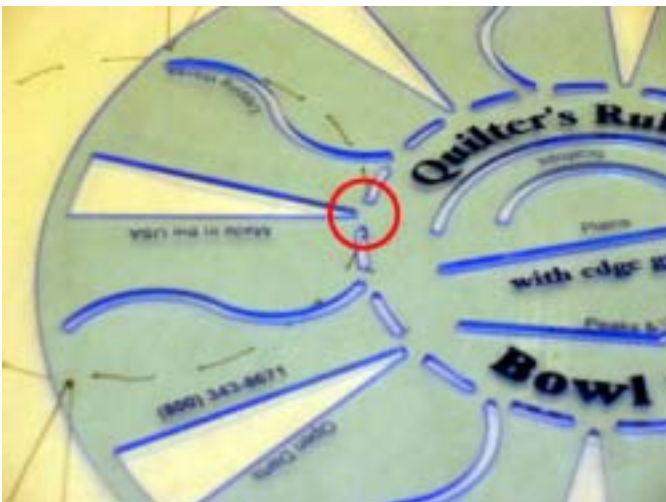
Place your Quilter's Rule Bowl Maker at the edge of your fabric*. Align the Open Darts to north, south, east, and west as pictured.



Trace from 1 o'clock, counter-clockwise, to 5 o'clock around the outside of the template. Next, fill in all Open Darts between 1 o'clock and 5 o'clock, as traced. Draw in all of the inner circle. See finished drawing in picture to right.



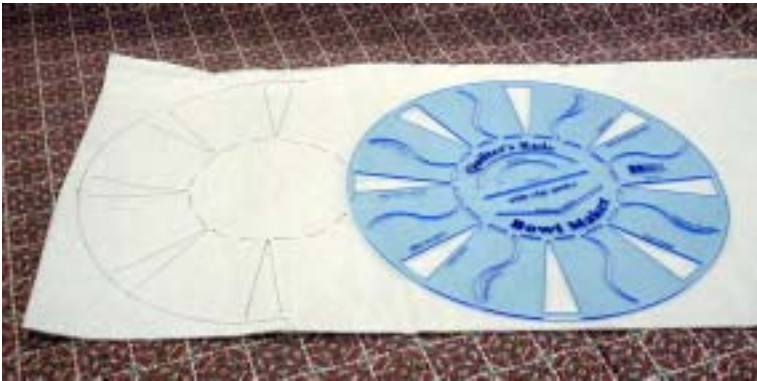
Slide Bowl Maker to right aligning the inner circle with the drawn inner circle ... OR ... <next page>



* Okay, so Green Bay didn't make it this year but we couldn't get our hands on other team fabrics.

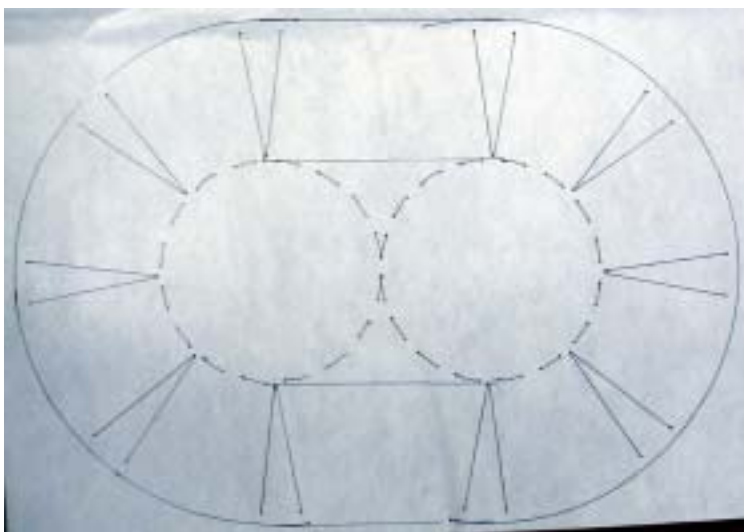
* For demonstration purposes, Stiff Stuff was used for our pictures. Please draw your design on your fabric (refer to Step 1 of the Quilter's Rule Bowl Maker instructions)

Slide even further to make a longer basket!
It's up to you.

Trace from 11 o'clock, clockwise, to 7 o'clock. Again, trace the inner circle. Then draw in Open Darts from 11 o'clock to 7 o'clock. See picture to right for final product.



Connect your two inner circles and outer circles to complete your basket pattern. Sew your basket using the Bowl Maker general instructions. Sew along your new oval markings!

The optional handle can be made from two strips of fabric with Stiff Stuff in the middle. Insert the handle between a layer of fabric and Stiff Stuff before sewing the outside rim of the basket.
