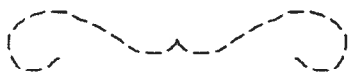
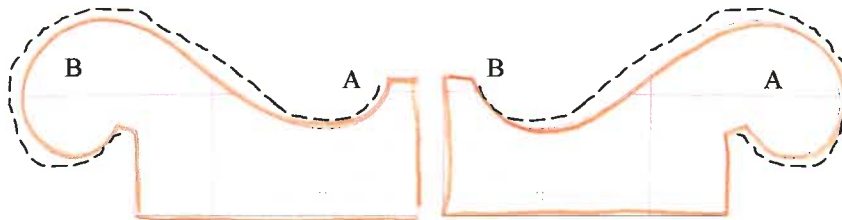


Linda Mae's Feather Plume

The trick to perfect feathers is creating perfectly symmetrical spines. What better way than stitching around a template!!! Once you have perfect spines, beautiful feathers are easy.

Mark the horizontal center of your border. This feather plume stitches out approximately 18 inches wide. Also mark the vertical center border and equally spaced centers across the border of the quilt. You can stitch a complete plume at the center of the border and half plumes on either side of it. Or you can stitch whole plumes evenly spaced around the quilt. Also, try combining this feather plume with the feather spine # 1 for a different look still.

Align the center point B with the vertical center of the border. Stitch from A to B around the template. Flip the tool horizontally and stitch the other side.

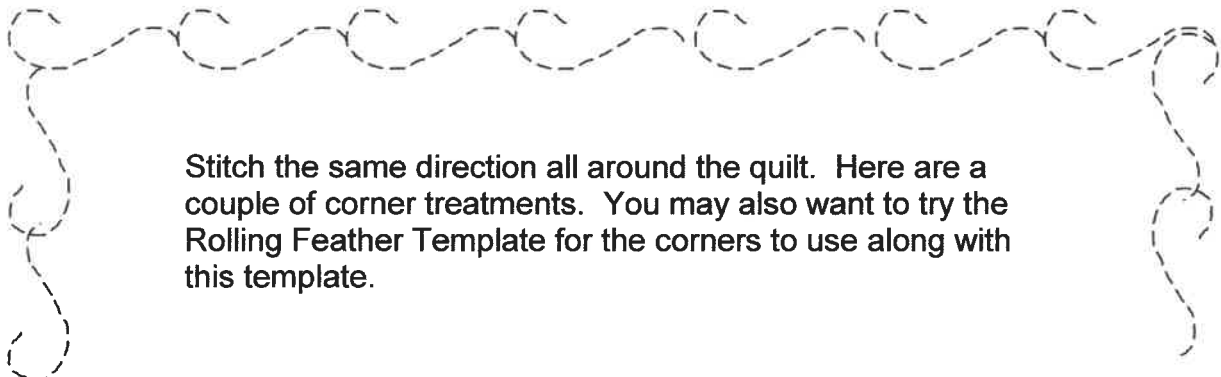
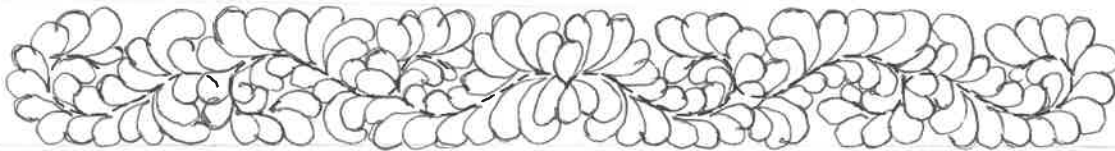


Stitch like this



Or flip the tool vertically and stitch like this.

More Ideas:



Stitch the same direction all around the quilt. Here are a couple of corner treatments. You may also want to try the Rolling Feather Template for the corners to use along with this template.
